USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 8 - 12 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** owls | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
