Location: street, avenue, park, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: columnar | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 15 - 21 m | **Width:** 9 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking, scented | **Flower colour:** yellow-green | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, wide, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown, green | **Twigs:** bare
