Location: park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, countryside, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 15 - 20 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

Flowers: corymbose, striking, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-yellow | **Flowering period:** June - June | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** cordate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, nut | **Fruit colour:** grey-green | **Bark colour:** brown, grey-black | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown-green
