Tree types: standard trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 3 - 5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, striking, standing, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** cream-yellow | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, small | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown, green
