Tree types: standard trees | **Topiary on stem:** block

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting, shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal, wide pyramidal | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** limited to rare infestation by lice

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, standing, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** pale yellow | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** bright green, underside blue-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, cordate, small, polished | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown, green | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches, finely branched | **Root system:** deep, extensive, highly branched, root suckers
