TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees | **Topiary on stem:** candelabra

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, car park / parking lot, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, ecological zone | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** not affected by infestations of lice

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, pendulous, scented | **Flower colour:** cream-yellow | **Flowering period:** July - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, big, wide, matt polished, underside hairy, serrate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, small, nut | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels | **Root system:** deep, extensive, coarse roots
