Tree types: standard trees, feathered trees

USE

Location: avenue, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow pyramidal | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 20 - 30 m | **Width:** 10 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5
