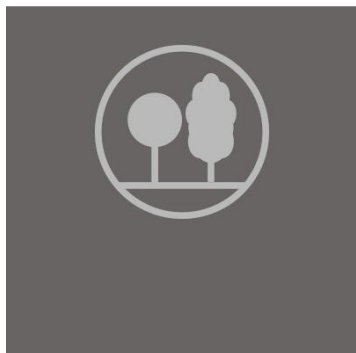


Tilia platyphyllos 'Pannonia'



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 4 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** limited to rare infestation by lice

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** daffodil | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, cordate, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, small, drupe | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** hairy
