Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, windbreak, coastal area | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, Eco planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 25 m | **Width:** 10 - 12 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, nectar value 5, pollen value 5 | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, not affected by infestations of lice

Flowers: corymbose, pendulous, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** daffodil | **Flowering period:** July - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside felty white, underside grey-green | **Leaves:** deciduous, orbicular, cordate, leathery, polished, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow, golden yellow, yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete, small, raceme | **Fruit colour:** grey-green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth, later on rough | **Twig colour:** grey-green | **Twigs:** hairy, bare, vertical branches, thickly branched | **Root system:** deep, extensive, coarse roots
