Tree types: standard trees, shade trees

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none, open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: narrow oval | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 18 - 20 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, resistant to Dutch elm disease 3, curiosity

Flowers: raceme, discrete | **Flower colour:** pale green | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** bright green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, small, serrate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, winged, small, raceme, nut | **Fruit colour:** brown, green | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** bare, vertical branches, finely branched | **Root system:** deep, shallow, extensive, highly branched, central root, on own root
