TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, half-stem trees, climate trees | **Topiary on stem:** roof-trained

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** Climate planting, urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 6 - 7 m | **Width:** 5.5 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist, wet | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: heads, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** yellow, red-brown | **Flowering period:** March - March | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds bright green, underside pale green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, rough, serrate, dentate | **Autumn colour:** yellow | **Fruits:** striking, winged, raceme, nut | **Fruit colour:** pale green | **Bark colour:** grey-black | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels, zigzagging, pendulous | **Root system:** shallow, extensive, tap root
