Location: park, large garden, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: wide weeping | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 4 - 6 m | **Width:** 5 - 8 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8B

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies
