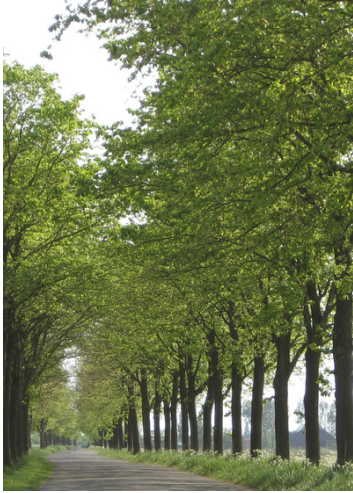


# *Ulmus* x *hollandica* 'Commelin'

## Commelin Dutch Elm



### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** standard trees, shade trees

### USE

**Location:** street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, ecological zone, coastal area | **Pavement:** sealed

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** ovoid | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 8 - 10 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8A

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution, resistant to Dutch elm disease 1

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** raceme, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished, dentate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** discrete, winged | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown
