USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** open, sealed

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide egg-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 20 - 30 m | **Width:** 20 - 25 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 8A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, discrete, small | **Flower colour:** red-violet | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished, underside hairy, dentate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** winged | **Fruit colour:** grey-brown | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** deeply furrowed | **Twig colour:** dark grey | **Twigs:** hairy
