



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | Topiary on stem: multi-stem umbrella | Topiary: bonsai

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden | Pavement: none, open, sealed | Planting concepts: Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded, ovoid, wide oval | Crown structure: dense | Height: 3 - 4.5 m | Width: 3 - 5 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist, wet | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: neutral, alkaline | Host plant/forage plant: butterflies | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: discrete | Flower colour: red-brown | Flowering period: March - March | Leaf colour: green | Leaves: deciduous, lanceolate, rough, doubly serrate | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: winged, nut | Fruit colour: red-brown | Bark colour: green, grey | Bark: spiral | Twig colour: brown
