TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: standard trees, multi-stemmed trees, shade trees, characteristic trees | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: street, avenue, square, park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, countryside, coastal area | **Pavement:** open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** urban planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 12 - 15 m | **Width:** 12 - 15 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 10A

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, slightly tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution, tolerates heat

Flowers: discrete | **Flower colour:** red | **Flowering period:** August - September | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, polished, serrate | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow, red-violet | **Fruits:** winged, small | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** golden yellow, orange, cinnamon-brown, grey-blue, green | **Bark:** peeling | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** hairy
