USE

Location: street, park, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, coastal area | **Pavement:** open, sealed | **Planting concepts:** Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 5 - 6 m | **Width:** 2 - 4 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerant to dryness

Flowers: raceme, discrete | **Flower colour:** red-brown | **Flowering period:** March - April | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** golden yellow | **Fruits:** winged, small | **Fruit colour:** pale brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** corky
