Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 2.5 m | **Width:** 2 - 2.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, trumpet-shaped, scented | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** January - February | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** deciduous, obovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** dark brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** dark brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels | **Root system:** shallow
