USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: raceme, corymbose, infundibular, striking, singular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** November - March | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, lanceolate, polished, scented with contusion, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** rarely fruits, raceme, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** bare, with lenticels, vertical branches, pendulous | **Root system:** deep, extensive,
