TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, infundibular, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** pale pink | **Flowering period:** January - March | **Leaf colour:** matt green | **Leaves:** deciduous, lanceolate, big | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** slightly furrowed | **Twig colour:** dark brown
