### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2.5 - 3 m | **Width:** 2.5 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 8B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (4.5 - 7.5) | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** umbels, spherical, striking, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, green | **Leaves:** semi-evergreen, ovate, polished, dentate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, red | **Fruits:** discrete, drupe | **Fruit colour:** red, blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** grey-brown | **Twigs:** bare | **Root system:** shallow
