Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** semi-open | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: spherical, striking, big, scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, polished | **Autumn colour:** red | **Fruits:** striking, toxic, berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Twig colour:** red-brown
