Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, large garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, grey-green, underside brown | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, underside hairy, dentate | **Autumn colour:** orange-red, dark red | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** green, grey | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-green | **Twigs:** hairy
