



TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement**: none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | Crown structure: dense | Height: 1 - 2 m | Width: 1 - 2 m | Winter hardiness zone: 5B - 7B

ASPECTS

Wind: intolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, peaty, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic, neutral, alkaline

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, strongly scented | Flower colour: white-pink, pale pink | Flowering period: April - May | Leaf colour: buds bronze, green, underside brown | Leaves: deciduous, ovate, underside hairy, dentate | Autumn colour: orange-red, dark red | Fruits: drupe | Fruit colour: blue-black | Bark colour: green, grey | Bark: smooth | Twig colour: grey-green | Twigs: hairy
