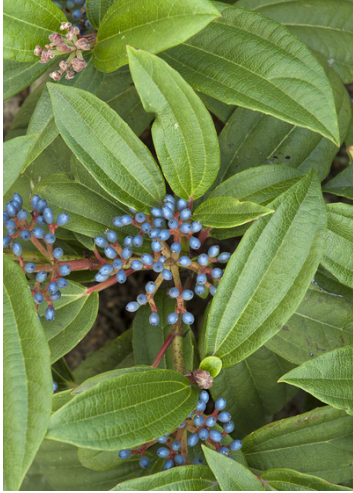


Viburnum davidii

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth, ground cover

USE

Location: park, central reservation, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 0.5 - 0.8 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral (5.5 - 7.0) | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, flat, striking, flower-scented | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, lanceolate, leathery, slightly hairy, dentate | **Fruits:** striking, raceme, drupe | **Fruit colour:** blue | **Bark colour:** red-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** red-brown | **Twigs:** with lenticels, horizontal branches | **Root system:** shallow
