TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: wide oval | **Crown structure:** open | **Height:** 1 - 3 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking, standing, strongly scented | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** February - March | **Leaf colour:** buds bronze, dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid, dentate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** berry | **Fruit colour:** red-violet | **Bark colour:** cinnamon-brown | **Twig colour:** red-brown
