**Tree types:** solitary shrubs

### USE

**Location:** park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** narrow vase-shaped | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.5 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9B

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** intolerant to wind | **Soil:** sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** corymbose | **Flower colour:** cream-white | **Flowering period:** June - July | **Leaf colour:** dark green, buds pale green | **Leaves:** ovoid, polished | **Autumn colour:** orange, dark red | **Fruits:** berry | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** green
