Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement:** none

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Width:** 1 - 1.5 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 4A - 8B

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind, tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies, birds | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution
