TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 3 - 5 m | **Width:** 4 - 6 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** butterflies

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, serrate | **Autumn colour:** red-violet | **Fruits:** no fruit | **Bark colour:** brown | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** hairy
