Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: flattened spherical | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Width:** 1.2 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry, moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline

Flowers: umbels, striking | **Flower colour:** white, pink | **Flowering period:** June - August | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** dark red | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** red | **Bark colour:** brown, green | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** brown-green
