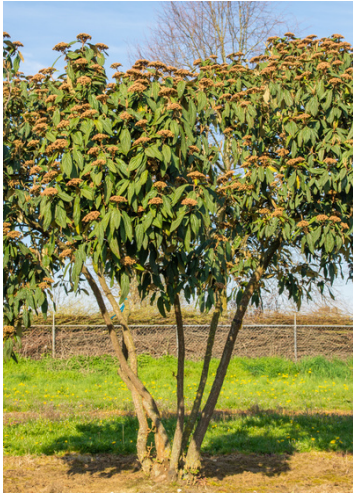


# Viburnum 'Rhytidocarpum'

### TYPES OF PLANTING

**Tree types:** solitary shrubs | **Topiary on stem:** multi-stem umbrella

### USE

**Location:** park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

### CHARACTERISTICS

**Crown shape:** rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 6A - 9A

### ASPECTS

**Wind:** slightly tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

### PLANTKENMERKEN

**Flowers:** corymbose, big | **Flower colour:** white | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** dark green, underside felty white | **Leaves:** semi-evergreen, lanceolate, underside hairy | **Autumn colour:** scarlet | **Fruits:** striking, berry | **Fruit colour:** red, black | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Twig colour:** pale brown | **Twigs:** hairy
