TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: half-stem trees, solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting:** undergrowth

USE

Location: park, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none | **Planting concepts:** shade-tolerant

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 8A - 10B

ASPECTS

Soil: sabulous clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** dry | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade, shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: corymbose, striking, weakly scented | **Flower colour:** white, white-pink | **Flowering period:** January - May | **Leaf colour:** dark green | **Leaves:** evergreen, ovoid, opposite, polished | **Fruits:** drupe | **Fruit colour:** blue-black | **Bark colour:** brown | **Bark:** smooth | **Twig colour:** pale brown, green
