Wind: tolerant to wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | Nutrient level: low in nutrients, moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: dry, moist | Light requirements: sun, partial shade | pH range: acidic | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies, nectar value 3, pollen value 3 | Extreme environments: tolerates air pollution

Flowers: corymbose, trumpet-shaped, big, strongly scented | Flower colour: red, pink-red, pink | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: dark red, red-green | Leaves: deciduous, lanceolate, wide | Autumn colour: yellow | Fruits: rarely fruits | Bark colour: cream | Bark: furrowed | Twig colour: red-brown, red, green | Twigs: bare | Root system: shallow, highly branched
