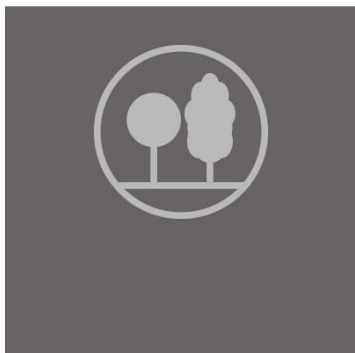

TYPES OF PLANTING

Tree types: solitary shrubs

USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 2 - 3 m | **Width:** 2 - 3 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5A - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, peaty, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil, all soils | **Nutrient level:** moderately rich in nutrients, rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun, partial shade | **pH range:** acidic, neutral, alkaline | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies | **Extreme environments:** tolerates air pollution

Flowers: trumpet-shaped, striking | **Flower colour:** white-pink | **Flowering period:** May - June | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovate | **Autumn colour:** yellow-brown | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
