USE

Location: park, central reservation, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery | **Pavement:** none

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown shape: rounded | **Crown structure:** dense | **Height:** 1 - 2 m | **Width:** 1 - 2 m | **Winter hardiness zone:** 5B - 8B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind | **Soil:** loess, sabulous clay, light clay, loamy soil | **Nutrient level:** rich in nutrients | **Soil moisture level:** moist | **Light requirements:** sun | **pH range:** acidic, neutral | **Host plant/forage plant:** bees, butterflies, birds

Flowers: infundibular, striking, scented | **Flower colour:** pink | **Flowering period:** April - May | **Leaf colour:** green | **Leaves:** deciduous, ovoid | **Autumn colour:** brown | **Fruits:** discrete, capsule | **Fruit colour:** brown | **Bark colour:** grey-brown | **Bark:** furrowed | **Twig colour:** grey-brown
