Tree types: solitary shrubs | **Other types of planting**: climbing plants

USE

Location: park, in containers, roof garden, large garden, small garden, patio, cemetery, traffic areas, industrial zones, coastal area | **Pavement**: none | **Planting concepts**: Prairie planting

CHARACTERISTICS

Crown structure: semi-open | Height: 7 - 10 m | Width: 7 - 10 m | Winter hardiness zone: 6B - 9B

ASPECTS

Wind: tolerant to wind, tolerant to coastal wind | Soil: loess, sabulous clay, heavy clay, light clay, sand, loamy soil | Nutrient level: rich in nutrients | Soil moisture level: moist | Light requirements: sun | pH range: acidic, neutral (5.5 - 7.5) | Host plant/forage plant: bees, butterflies | Extreme environments: tolerant to dryness, tolerates air pollution

PLANTKENMERKEN

Flowers: raceme, papilionaceous, striking, pendulous, big, strongly scented, second bloom | Flower colour: blue-violet | Flowering period: May - June | Leaf colour: green, buds pale green | Leaves: deciduous, lanceolate, pinnate | Autumn colour: golden yellow | Fruits: hairy, toxic, pod | Fruit colour: grey-green | Bark colour: grey | Bark: slightly furrowed, spiral | Twig colour: grey-brown | Twigs: bare | Root system: deep, extensive, root suckers,
